It was moved on a motion made by Comrs. Bonnano/Ciancio to accept the Chief's report for February 2022. MC. Activity report for January 2022: alarms 35 for 340 hours; meetings 2 for 60 hours; misc. 10 for 114 hours; drills 7 for 168 hours. Total hours: 682.

Chief Kohany reported 2/5 members attended Elmsford Seminar; members attended memorial services for firefighter Andrew Bratton and former Lt. Chris Colasacco; members responded to a structure fire in Pleasantville 2/8; met with MPPD on an incident that occurred on 1/17; met with Blythedale representatives on the ongoing construction – there will be trailers placed at the rear of the building; 2/16 C&O training – requested to use district headquarters.

Comr. Ciancio reported Family Medical will provide a list of dates available for physicals – they still are not currently scheduling – members can get physicals from their own doctor or Partners in Safety; NYS has redistricted State Senators – this could affect current VFD approved grants; Groenewegen gear was cleaned by AAA then he received a new set of gear – this is not the protocol for cleaning or ordering gear; will ask neighboring departments for recommendations on washing machines suitable for gear cleaning; cascade unit was serviced – parts are not available for repair, cost of a new machine by Bauer is \$99,470; SCBAs expire 2022 – the cost for 52 replacements \$462,364; ordered 24 new pages 12/18/21, not yet received; portable trunk radios need to be purchased for apparatus – County did not and will not replace those after updating their radio system – the cost to purchase 2 mobile radios \$6,000.00/each and 7 portables at \$8,800/each.

Comr. Bonanno reported he will do an insurance audit of all District policies and carriers; will schedule Defensive Driving course for April.

Chairman Deegan reported that Service Award points have been posted for 30-days – ok to move forward with certification letter for Independent Fire Co., VFC #1 will submit attendance for Hurricane Ida from September 2021 to have points updated and reposted.

It was moved on a motion made by Comrs. Deegan/Bonanno to authorize 3 district officials to attend the Annual Meeting 5/5-5/8 at a cost of \$460.00 per person. MC.

It was moved on a motion made by Comrs. Bonanno/Ciancio to purchase chains for R9. MC.

It was moved on a motion made by Comrs. Bonanno/Ciancio to publish a legal notice for the purchase of 52 new SCBA bottles at a cost not to exceed \$465,000.00. MC.

There was a discussion on the County not replacing radios.

With no other business to come before the Board of Fire Commissioners, it was moved on a motion made by Comrs. Deegan/Bonanno to adjourn the meeting at 8:44pm. MC.
