It was moved on a motion made by Comrs. Sciliano/Lester to accept as read the Treasurer's Report, the bills submitted for payment be approved, and transfers executed. MC. Chairman Ciancio abstained from voting on check #7433 and 7434 as this is his daughter.

### **SECRETARY'S REPORT**

Secretary Ciancio reported the NYS Report was filed February 27; received signed Service Award certifications from both companies – will use a simplified form starting next year that was provided by Firefly Admin; Maxine Casalbore has taken over as sole insurance broker for all district policies – will have more communication throughout the year than with previous brokers; submitted final report to Stayin' Alive Charity on how the grant was used; Resolution 79 requires amendment to reflect Comr. Lester as new contact; received and replied to 2 FOIL requests, neither had to do with VFD; Chief's report may not be accurate as there were not any attendance sheets for February from VFC #1; contacted stamps.com and was able to lower the monthly fee by \$10; mailed list of qualifying members to the Town for annual pool passes; received notice from the Town Comptroller that his last day will be 3/15/24; received updated insurance cards for all vehicles; discussion on accurately keeping track of member's annual requirements.

It was moved on a motion made by Comrs. Lester/Sciliano to accept the Secretary's report. MC.

#### **CHIEF'S REPORT**

It was moved on a motion made by Comrs. Sciliano/Ciancio to accept the Chief's report for March 2024. MC. Activity report for February 2024: alarms 35 for 484 hours; 1 drill for 39 hours; 2 meetings for 70 hours; misc. 7 for 68 hours. Total hours: 661.

Assistant Chief DiPrinzio reported the department responded to a FAST team call in Elmsford 2/6; structure fire on Livingston Ave 2/16; 3/14 flag detail for Thornwood FD; updates made to EOC, more training for members will be scheduled; IAmResponding now working in HQ apparatus bay; will schedule joint live burn drill with Chappaqua over the summer; possible training inside WMC; correspondence sent to County on eliminating siren for any alarms other than structure fire; attended meeting for annual fireworks at Kensico Dam; created slack group for members to share information and improve communication; alias for E83 updated to E82; construction continuing at WMC – will meet with Rob Russell of Grasslands Fire Brigade for walkthrough; the County is working on a new CAD that will be integrated with MPPD to be launched mid-year; discussions were had on a townwide backup frequency that will be maintained by MPPD for town fire departments and EMS during storms; requested Captains take 2 Chief cars while he is out of town 3/26-4/2.

### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Comr. Sciliano reported requested up to \$12,000 allowance for the purchase of a forcible entry door prop. MC.

Comr. Ciancio reported the recently purchased Motorola 7550 radios are now discontinued and will try to find a vendor who may have some still in stock for purchase to keep equipment consistent; Firefighter Equipment of NY offers to come on site to repair gear, rather than sending it out; issue with mics on the engines will be repaired to eliminate voice cutting out; Town indicated Munger Pavilion will be condemned and torn down; onsite physicals will be held 5/13 and 10/7; discussed equipment needed for VFC #1; discussed refurbishing Rescue 59 at a cost that would not exceed \$300,000 as opposed to replacing it with a brand new apparatus.

Comr. Lester reported a letter was sent to Firefly Admin to add him as trustee and remove Ex-Commissioner Deegan; met with Kevin from KD Systems on various technology issues to be addressed; will meet with Security World on a backup door lock system if the fob system goes down.

Chairman Bonanno reported all insurances have been renewed; Maxine Casalbore is sole insurance broker for the district; would like to schedule the Board to meet with the insurance agent at 6:30pm before April 10 meeting for explanation on each policy the district holds; suggested when a member turns 75, if they have the accident policy already, they are given the option to keep it or move to the dental/vision policy.

It was moved on a motion made by Comrs. Ciancio/Sciliano to amend Resolution 79. MC.

It was moved on a motion made by Comrs. Ciancio/Sciliano to allow the Captains to drive the Chief cars while Assistant Chief DiPrinzio is out of town 3/26-4/2. MC.

It was moved on a motion made by Comrs. Sciliano/Ciancio to accept approval of the Service Award certifications for both companies. MC.

It was moved on a motion made by Comrs. Sciliano/Lester to approve up to \$12,000 for the purchase of a forcible entry door prop. MC.

It was moved on a motion made by Comrs. Ciancio/Sciliano to approve up to \$300,000 to refurbish and update equipment to NFPA standards on Rescue 59. MC.

There was a discussion on keeping accurate attendance for members as they complete their annual requirements.

With no other business to come before the Board of Fire Commissioners, it was moved on a motion made by Comrs. Sciliano/Lester to adjourn the meeting at 8:39pm. MC.
